





Play it Fair! Stickers and Tattoos

Use the Play it Fair! stickers and temporary tattoos to highlight positive values, children's rights and participation.

Purpose of the Stickers and Tattoos

 To help promote and reinforce the Play it Fair! values in children's everyday lives

How to Use the Tattoos and Stickers

- Review the Play it Fair! values and the examples provided on Reference Sheet 6 in the Toolkit.
- 2. Select one value to focus on in your session.
- See below for instructions on how to print your values stickers and/or order your values tattoos.
- 4. Choose an activity that promotes the selected value to do with the children.
- At the end of the activity, hand out one sticker/tattoo to everyone in your group.
- 6. Ask the children to look for ways they practice the selected value at home to share with the group at the next session. For example, if the value is responsibility, a child might share how they washed the dishes after dinner. Encourage the children to discuss the value with their parents and think of some examples together.
- 7. At the next session, record all the children's examples of practicing the selected value on a large piece of paper

and post on the wall. Consider having the children decorate it. Repeat the activity until you have examples of your group practicing all seven of the Play it Fair! values. Use the posters to reinforce positive behaviour in your group by referring to them in group discussions.

Alternative Uses

- Arts and crafts activities
- Hand out tattoos/stickers to <u>all</u> the children in your group at special events like Play it Fair! Day.

How to Print the Stickers

- The value sticker PDF file is formatted so you can print off as many stickers as you need, simply use AVERY 5163 labels (or the generic equivalent) in your printer!
