### CONTEXT

The popular uprisings in Morocco and Tunisia since 2011 have highlighted the crucial role of women and youth in social change. However, social and economic exclusion, inequality, lack of transparency and accountability are still major issues and are exacerbated by the pandemic since 2020. Since 2006, Equitas and its partners have been implementing education programs that contribute to the empowerment and mobilization of groups subject to discrimination in order to bring about positive change and influence local authorities. Civil society is an essential counterweight to government power and a means of expression for citizens.
